Minutes

Prayer and pledge led by Robert Walling

Approval of March minutes — motion by Robert and seconded by Virginia

In attendance Virginia Lewis, Robert Walling, Thomas Champagne, Monica Blankenship, Julie Neely, Jeffery Angel, Jonathan Zadick and Katie Kortekaas

The only Customers present for customer concerns were Jeffery Angel and Kelly Angel, but Robert did speak to the Kara Dyer meter issue, and it was decided that she would pay the \$50 new service fee and pay for the cut lock, it was also decided that Paul Brock will have to pay the remaining balance on his leak after the ServLine payment. The utility cannot forgive any of the balance owed as per the utility policy. Motion made by Robert and seconded by Virginia. Mr. Jeffery Angel asked the board to allow him to use the locked-out meter under Sandra Angle. The board said they did not know the legal aspect of that and asked Monica to contact TAUD's attorney and find out, the board also asked Monica to contact ServLine and see if there is an option for customers to pay for additional coverage above the \$1000 one time a year coverage, and to check into other leak companies to see if we can find a better cheaper option for our customers.

Jonathan said the diamond maps have been completed, and the Asset Management Plan was submitted to the state 2 months ago and there has been no response from the state yet. Jonathan also said he will prepare the easement for the Wyatt Loop line.

Thomas provided his monthly treatment plant update and an update on the Treatment Plant Upgrades.

The meter TAP request we have on the current waiting list were approved that is a total of 18 new meters approved. A new waiting list will be started, and the board will review the list each month. Motion by Virginia and second by Robert.

Tabled to the May meeting was, Drug Policy review, Leave and attendance slip, updating business accounts and the extra minimum Charge,

There was discussion of the Muni -Link meeting and Updating Credit Card limits for Thomas, Calvin and Ricky. Also, Jessica has been keeping up with the bank collateral issue every month and she said we have enough at this time.

Thomas and Monica will investigate if we need to determine a fee structure for Hydrant Meters.

There was a vote to go ahead and order 2 flow meters Motion made by Virginia and seconded by Robert.
