Minutes

Prayer and pledge led by Leon Deweese

Approval of May minutes — motion by Virginia and seconded by Leon

In attendance Leon Deweese Virginia Lewis, Thomas Champagne, Monica Blankenship, Julie Neely, Jonathan Zadick, Todd Quatro, Tina Scraboro, Terry Angel, Amy Moody Toker, Travis Holloway and Rita Mayfield.

Terry Angel came to speak to the board again about his bill, the board informed him they could not forgive the past due bill, it will have to be paid, and at least \$2,000 will have to be paid before his water can be restored. He was provided with info on some agencies that might be able to help him. Mrs. Mayfield asked questions about the new service charge, and the board explained the situation to her that required us to add the fee.

Jonathan informed the board that he should have some plans for the pumping station ready this month, and the hydraulic mapping is done. Monica is going to email Jonthan with info about Mr. Fred Clark on Tuesday so he can investigate that situation also and see if there is anything further, we can do to help him.

Mr. Quatro asked the board to allow them to add 5 more tiny homes to the existing meter until they can fix the water situation in Incredible Tiny Homes the answer was no.

Thomas asked for permission to purchase a dump trailer for maintenance, so they can haul gravel on their own and dump it when needed. Motion to approve was made by Leon and seconded by Virginia.

There was a motion made by Leon and seconded by Virginia to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> waiting list for meter installs.

Monica and Julie were asked to contact Paul Brock and inform him that the bill for his leak needs to be paid soon, or we would lock the meter, as no attempt has been made over the several months since the leak to pay on it at all.

A motion was made by Virginia and seconded by Leon to add Thomas Champagne, General Manager of the utility, to all Bank Accounts Including Credit Cards and CD's at both First Farmers and Commercial Bank and Citizen's Tri-County Bank. Thomas will be able to make requests regarding credit card limit changes and adding credit cards to the utility accounts for employees as needed.

Items 9, 10, 11 and 12 on the agenda were Tabled until that July Meeting.

A motion to adjourn was made by Leon and seconded by Virginia.
